Who can apply to CEP?

- Eligible for grade 10 placement
 - 15 years old on or before September 30
 - Positive attitude toward work and be prepared to participate in employment activities
 - Must be 16 years old before participating in work experience

Facts about CEP

- Students graduate with a high school diploma
 - Students graduate with their peers and are involved in all aspects of high school life
 - Students can leave CEP at any grade level and return to the academic stream
 - Students can go to a post secondary institution, ex. NSCC

- Landscaping

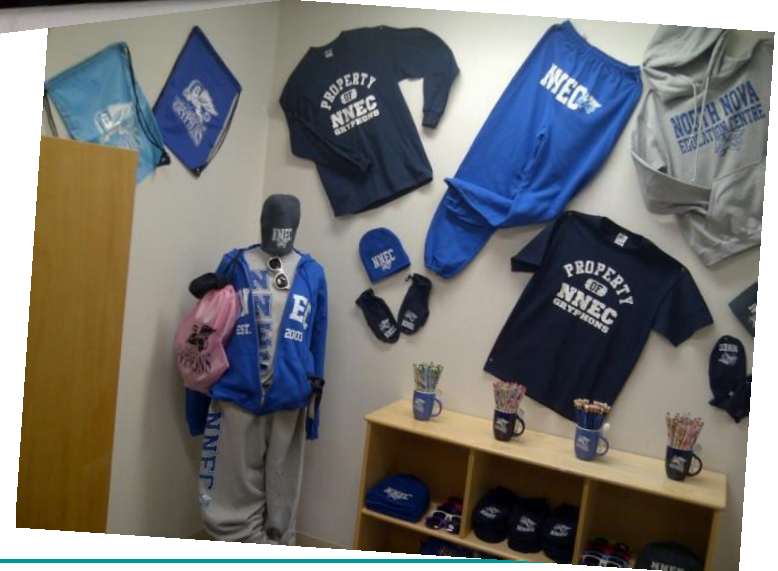
