The David Fry Memorial Bursary has been established to remember David, his contributions to competitive swimming in Nova Scotia, and to encourage swimmers toward

excellence. David's coaching career in swimming spanned over forty years. Each year awards may be made from the Fund to promising, Nova Scotia swimmers to assist them to continue their training, education, and pursuit of their swimming goals as they pursue their University education.

8. Jordan Boyd Leadership Award & Scholarship

The Jordan Boyd Leadership Award & Scholarship has been established to recognize individuals in amateur hockey, in the form a series of scholarships, who have demonstrated a passion for sportsmanship, learning, leadership and community. To be eligible:

- Registered during current playing season with Hockey Nova Scotia or NSSAF (hockey) as a member in good standing as either a player or on-ice official.
- Must graduate from high school same year the award is presented.
- Must commence post-secondary studies at a Canadian University or Community College in the same year the award is presented or the first year after Junior eligibility if playing Jr Hockey.
- Must be committed to the principle of fair play and sportsmanship.
- Applicant must write a short essay explaining why they are deserving of receiving this award and how they have met the criteria.
